Diesel change could save €250m

Dublin: One of Ireland's leading logistics and transport firms has called on the Government to abolish all colouring of diesel and to introduce a fuel rebate in December's Budget, in a move that could generate €250 million for the exchequer.

Chairman of **TPN**, Owen **Cooke**, which employs over 60 people at its Dublin transport hub, said: "An already fragile transport and freight industry will suffer more dire consequences if the Government does not rectify the on-going issue of coloured diesel being illegally washed and sold as road diesel."
